BRING YOUR VETTE TO THE NATIONALS!

All Corvettes are invited to attend the Show 'n' Shine day at the 2023 Ballarat Gold Rush Corvette Nationals. This takes place on Saturday March 25th, 2023 on the shores of Lake Wendouree. This gathering will be known as the "Corvette Bonanza".

The details are as set out below -

- The offer is open to all Chevrolet Corvettes, but only Corvettes
- There is no charge to be part of the Corvette Bonanza
- Corvette Bonanza cars will not be involved in judging, which is applicable only to 'officially entered' cars
- A separate area has been set aside for the Corvette Bonanza cars which we believe will hold up to approximately 100 Corvettes, depending on the tightness of parking
- Cars will be able to enter this nominated area from 9:00am on Saturday morning
- When the area has been filled, we reserve the right to refuse any more Corvettes for parking in this nominated area there will be signs and attendants to assist entry
- This area is as detailed in the attached map, on the northern side of the "Australian Ex-Prisoners of War Memorial"
- Entry to the area is via Carlton Street through a gate that will be opened at 9:00am.
- By entering the area, you agree your Corvette will be available for viewing by the public
- It is expected your Corvette will be cleaned, polished, and in a 'display' condition
- Note that cars are parked at the owner's risk and should be locked if left unattended
- The Show 'n' Shine finishes at 3:00pm and all Corvettes should depart the area by 3:30pm



The Gold Rush Nationals takes place over the weekend of 24-27 March, 2023. It is open to all members of Incorporated Australian Corvette Clubs. This year's event has been fully booked out.

The Show 'n' Shine element of the event will be held along Windmill Drive, which will be closed off for the day. GMSV will have a large stand at the show, displaying their cars and providing vehicle information. There will also be a Show Headquarters tent which will have Nationals Memorabilia for sale as well as providing show information.

There will be food and coffee trucks available, as well as the nearby Farmers' Market. The Lake Wendouree precinct also has many attractions to keep you interested.
